Cedar Group is committed to protection of the environment. The business aims to save natural resources by awareness and review of all operations employed by the Company.


This commitment extends to all areas of the business. It further aims to prevent pollution and continually improve its environmental performance in order to safeguard the quality of the environment both locally and globally.
